NOW ENROLLING Kindergarten 2020

Our office staff have been helping lots of parents enrol kindergarten students for



2020. Remember, if you have a child who will be turning 5 before 31 July 2020, and you are intending to enrol them for next year, please complete an application form at your earliest convenience and return it to the office. Even if you already have children attending the school, we need a completed application form for each new student commencing in 2020. You can download enrolment forms by clicking ENROLMENT FORMS. The Department of Education has these forms translated in many languages.

As you are aware, we have a growing student population and limited space in our school hall. For this reason, we will be holding multiple sessions throughout the day to accommodate all students, teachers and parents.

As a way of saying thank you to the parents who have worked around the school in so many different capacities throughout the year, I would like to invite our parent helpers to a 'Thank You Morning Tea' on Thursday 5th December.

The morning tea will be held in the School Hall, commencing at 9:30am – 10:30am. This invitation is extended to members of the P&C, uniform shop, classroom volunteers, library and sport volunteers, scripture teachers and anyone else who has been actively working within the school during the year. CLASS ORGANISATION FOR 2020

The organisation of classes for next year is well underway, with another significant Kindergarten group and a number of new local students enrolling for 2020.

NSW Public Schools are provided with teachers and staff on an age-based differential formula. Once the Principal enters anticipated numbers of students, Department of Education staffing will allocate a set number of teachers and administration staff to each school.

It is then the Principal's job, with input from the school executive and teachers, to organise the best mix of classes and the best teacher allocation to suit the available resources.

As students are placed into classes, a wide range of factors are taken into account. Although this is not an exact science, the art of classroom placement for a student is a professionally responsible decision based on a combination of academic needs, social skills (or need to improve social skills), combinations with other students, the degree and number of high needs students within the cohort, special medical conditions, teacher expertise, and teaching and learning styles. Rarely do we get this placement wrong.

Parents will be provided with reasons for class placement of their child if requested. However, I want to make it very clear that it is very rarely possible to move one child from one class to another. The complexity of learning needs, classroom personalities and the interconnectedness of classroom interactions do not allow for such an easy 'swap' from one class to another. Whilst we will always listen to (and take into consideration) the concerns of parents, it is in the end, the decision of the Principal and the school as to where the best learning setting is for each individual student.

BUS & ROAD SAFETY

- Wait until the bus has gone, then use a safe place to cross e.g. school crossing

- Up until at least 10 years old, **supervise** closely and **hold your child's hand** when crossing the road.




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
